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Art. 1 - INTRODUCTION

Name: Rallye Casinos do Algarve 2026

Date: 1 to 3 October 2026

Art. 1.1 – Preamble

This event will be run in accordance with the International Sporting Code (ISC), the General Prescriptions for Automobile and Karting (PGA), the Specific Rally Prescriptions (PER), the Sporting and Technical Regulations applicable to the Championships and Trophies, these regulations and their appendices, all of which all competitors, by the mere fact of entering, undertake to respect. All these governing documents may be consulted at www.fia.com or www.fpak.pt.

Additional information or any changes and/or modifications to these Supplementary Regulations will be published “online” on the Official Notice Board in the **Sportity App / Pass: RCA**.

All official documents of the Rallye Casinos do Algarve will be published in Portuguese and this language shall be binding in the event of any discrepancy.

Art. 4 – ENTRY

4.1 – Closing of Entries

Wednesday, September 17, 2026, at 18:00.

4.2 – Registration procedure

All competitors must complete their registration in accordance with the provisions described in **Art. 5.1 of the PER**.

The registrations shall be in accordance with the provisions described in **Art. 9.3 of the PPAK**, from the publication of these Supplementary Regulations on the FPAK web portal (<https://portal.fpak.pt>) until 18:00 on 17-09-2026.

4.3 – Registration Validation

The registration shall only be considered valid upon receipt of the respective payment.

For competitors **without an FPAK license and without an FPAK Technical Passport** (other ASNs)

It is necessary to upload the following documents:

- Identification of the Drivers (Citizen Card, ID Card or Passport);
- Competitor, Driver and Co-driver licenses;
- Driver and Co-driver driving licenses;
- ASN authorization for foreign drivers;
- Competition vehicle documents (Registration Certificate and Proof of Ownership or Single Vehicle Document).
- Page of the Homologation Form showing the Group and Engine Capacity;
- FIA Technical Passport and/or other ASNs

Vehicle authorization, in the event that the vehicle is not owned by:

- Competitor
- Team
- 1st Driver
- 2nd Driver/Navigator

It is mandatory to submit (upload to the FPAK Portal) an authorization signed and duly certified by the owner, authorizing the participation of the respective vehicle in the Rallye Casinos do Algarve.

4.4 – RoadBook

Roadbook will be distributed in digital format.

A physical format will only be made available upon request at the time of registration, in accordance with **Art. 8.1 of the PER**, upon payment of an additional €25.00.

4.5 – SOS and OK Signals

The SOS and OK signal printed on A3-sized cards are the responsibility of the competitor. In accordance with **Art. 8.1.1 of the PER**.

4.6 – Maximum Number of Entries and Classes

The rally is limited to a maximum of **70 entries**.

If the number of entries exceeds the established limit, the selection criterion to be used will be the order of receipt and payment of the entry.

4.7 – Eligible Vehicles

All vehicles that comply with the Technical Regulations of the respective Championships referred to in **Art. 2.2 of these Supplementary Regulations and with Art. 6.1 of the PGA** are eligible to participate in the event.

4.9 - Billing and Payment Information:

4.9.1 - The billing details must be provided at the time of registration:

- Drivers/teams who require an **invoice with a company VAT number and/or another (without an FPAK license)** will have the **entry fee increased by VAT** at the legally applicable rate.

- Drivers/teams who require an **invoice in the name of a Legal Competitor or Driver/Co-driver/Team (with FPAK licenses)** will benefit from the **VAT exemption regime**, in accordance with the applicable legislation.

4.9.2 - After the entry has been validated by the club, a Multibanco payment reference will be automatically generated and made available to the competitor through the FPAK Portal and via the email provided.

4.9.3 - The entry payment will only be considered completed after successful payment of the respective Multibanco reference (**ATTENTION: the references are valid for 72 hours**).

4.9.4 - All entries received but not paid within the established deadline (**72 hours after the payment reference is issued**) will not be accepted or considered for selection purposes, should the number of entries exceed the fixed limit of 70 participants.

4.9.5 - The invoice corresponding to the entry payment will be issued according to the billing details provided at the time of registration and sent to the email address indicated therein.

4.10 – Entries Refund

Entries will be fully refunded:

- To applicants whose entries have not been accepted;
- In the event that the rally does not take place;

4.11 – Shakedown

Co-Drives (*only in the Shakedown*) - Those who do not hold a valid competition licence must request a Participation Authorisation (AP) from the organising club, at a cost of €45.00 (*without repatriation cover*), valid only for this event.

Applicants for the APs must report to the administrative checks of the event/competition (*event secretariat*) until 18:00 on 1 October 2026 and provide the following details: - Full name; ID; tax identification number; date of birth and declaration of responsibility.

Art. 8 - FUEL

8.1 – Permitted Fuel

In accordance with the Technical Regulations of the respective Championship.

8.2 – Refuelling Zones

The Rallye Casinos do Algarve has 2 refuelling zones, indicated on the route map and in the event RoadBook and identified as **RZ**.

RZ 1 – Start of the 2nd Leg, 3rd Section – TC 2H - Lagoa, exit from the S.P.

RZ 2 – End of the 3rd Section – TC 5B - Lagoa, exit from the S.P.

The first leg of the rally has no refuelling zone.

The use of ground protection equipment is mandatory.

8.2.1 – Operators in the Refuelling Zones

Refuelling operators, two per vehicle, must be identified by the wristband provided for this purpose and equipped with the clothing specified in **Art. 12.7.6 of the PER**.

8.2.2 – Fuel Transportation

According to the law, it is only permitted to carry 10 litres of fuel in the boot of the car. According to Article 61 of the Code of Excise Duties (CIEC), “atypical means of transport” is considered to be the transport of fuel that is not contained in the tank of a vehicle or in an appropriate reserve container, up to a limit of 10L.

Under the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (known as ADR), an individual may transport up to 240 litres of fuel in a car, provided that it is distributed in containers of 60 litres each. However, they must notify the Tax Authorities and pay any difference in taxes applicable to quantities exceeding the maximum permitted for jerry cans.

Art. 9 - RECONNAISSANCE

In accordance with **Art. 16 of the PER** and [Annex 2](#) of these regulations.

Art. 10 – ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1 – Documents to be Presented

In accordance with **Art. 15.1 of the PER**.

The documentary checks will preferably be carried out electronically (upload of documents to the FPAK Portal). During the in-person verification, the valid original driving licence must be presented, and the declaration printed by the organisation from the FPAK Portal, listing the documents submitted there at the time of registration, must be signed, confirming their validity and authenticity.

The collection of materials may be carried out by the competitor, the team representative, the 1st Driver, or the 2nd Driver/Co-Driver indicated on the entry form.

10.2 – Location and Time Schedule

The administrative checks will take place at the **Hotel Algarve Casino** in accordance with the Event Programme.

A detailed schedule for the checks will be published on the **Sportity App, Password: RCA, on Wednesday, 30 September at 19:00.**

Art. 11 – TECHNICAL CHECKS, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 – Documents to be Presented

When presented for the technical checks, the vehicles must be accompanied by the original documents mentioned in **Art. 15.2.2 of the PER**.

11.2 – Location and Time Schedule

The initial technical checks will take place at **Fatacil, in Lagoa**, in accordance with the Event Programme.

A detailed schedule for the checks will be published on the Sportity App on Wednesday, 30 September at 19:00.

11.3 – Sealing of Turbochargers, Superchargers, Gearboxes and Differentials

Fatacil, in Lagoa – technical scrutineering.

Art. 12 – OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

12.1 – Rally Start

Lagoa, Fatacil premises, TC 0 on 2 October at 15:35.

12.2 – Rally Finish

At TC 8A – Parc Fermé in Portimão.

12.3 – Early Check-In

Competitors may check in early without incurring any penalty at the following controls:

- At **TC 2F** – Exit from Service Park / Entry into Parc Fermé – Fatacil and at **TC 8A** – Entry into Parc Fermé in Portimão, competitors may check in early, in accordance with **Art. 19.10.6 of the PER**.
- **5C** – Entry to the Silves Regrouping Park. *(by derogation from FPAK)*

On the route between the Podium and the Parc Fermé, the vehicle may be driven by a person other than the Driver.

Competitors wishing to participate in the Test Session – Shakedown must complete the SHAKEDOWN entry form available on the Sportity App, together with the rally entry form, and proceed with payment.

The **Shakedown**, with a distance of **3.73 km**, is located from the service park in Lagoa:

Finish – 12.22 km

The Shakedown Service Park will be the same as for the Rally, located at Fatacil.

The Shakedown will be held in accordance with **Art. 17.5 of the PER**. Each competitor is entitled to complete a maximum of **3 Shakedown runs**.

ANNEX 5 – LAGOS CITY STAGE

The Lagos City Stage **does not count towards the rally classification** and is a demonstration event.

The Lagos City Stage is **mandatory** for all competitors.

- The surface is asphalt and tyres are free.
- The starting order will be as follows:
- First, the last 15 competitors on the starting order list for the 1st Section, in reverse order.
- All remaining competitors, following the starting order for the 1st Section.
- After the starting marshal's instruction, the competitor has **10 seconds to start**.
- The time achieved on the City Stage will not be recorded or attributed to the rally classification (there will be no timing cells).
- The maximum time allowed to complete the City Stage is **10 minutes**.
- Any vehicles unable to complete the City Stage (due to an accident or mechanical failure) will be removed and taken to the Service Park by the organiser's recovery vehicle.

ANNEX 6 – PORTIMÃO CITY STAGE

The Portimão City Stage **does not count towards the rally classification**.

It is a demonstration event and will take place immediately after the finish of the Rally.

- Held on the roads adjacent to the Final Parc Fermé.
- Mandatory for all competitors who finish the Rally.
- The surface is asphalt and the tyres used must be those used during the Rally.
- The maximum time allowed to complete the City Stage is **10 minutes**.
- Any retirement or mechanical failure occurring during the City Stage will not affect the Rally classification. In this situation, the organiser will tow the vehicle back to the Parc Fermé.

ANNEX 7 – PARC FERMÉ

The Start Park and the Parc Fermé at the end of the 1st Leg are located at **Fatacil, Lagoa**.

Start Park – All competitors' vehicles authorised to start the 1st Leg must obligatorily enter the Start Park, located at Fatacil, between **13:30 and 14:30 on Friday, 2 October**.

The Regrouping Park between the 1st Section and the City Stage is located in **Lagos**.

The Regrouping Park between the 3rd and 4th Sections is located in **Silves**.

Parc Fermé at the End of the Rally – Portimão, Escola Poeta António Aleixo, Rua Jaime Palhinha.

At Time Controls **2E** and **2F**, upon entry to the Service Park and Parc Fermé, competitors may check in early. (**TC 2E by derogation from FPAK**)

At **TC 2F**, entry into the Parc Fermé / exit from the Service Area at the end of the 1st Leg, which is adjacent to the Service Park, a person other than the drivers may present the vehicle at the control, (**by derogation from FPAK**) accompanied by the corresponding time card. The drivers remain responsible for the time at which the vehicle is presented at the control.

The speed limit throughout the entire Service Park is 30 km/h.

Location – There is only one Service Park throughout the Rally, located at Fatacil Park, EN 125, Lagoa.

A Service Park layout plan will be published, which all teams must comply with. The space allocated per entered competitor will be as follows:

- Teams with a **legal entity licence: 150 m²** for the first vehicle; an additional **50 m²** will be allocated for each additional vehicle.
- **Other competitors: 100 m².**
- **Southern 2WD Rally Championship competitors: 70 m².**

Trailers must be parked in the trailer parking area adjacent to the Service Park.

All competitors with structures that do not fit within the established limits must inform the organiser at least 7 days in advance.

The Service Park allocation plan may be amended when vehicles enter the Service Park for space-management reasons.

By **21 September**, competitors must inform the organiser if they intend to share their service area with another competing team. Failure to provide this information will result in the allocation of a location at the organiser's discretion, according to its criteria.

The use of **ground protection** in the Service Park is mandatory. It must cover the entire service area of the competition vehicle and must be made of waterproof material.

The organiser, together with its environmental partner, will provide separate waste-collection bags, which may be collected during the technical checks.

The Service Park is equipped with waste containers and recycling points. Competitors and all personnel involved in their service operations must deposit all waste generated in the designated containers.

Washing vehicles inside the Service Park is prohibited.

Used oil and tyres must not be disposed of in waste containers or left in the Service Park. **It is the competitor's responsibility to take them to appropriate recycling facilities.**

The Service Park must be completely cleared by **12:00 on 4 October**. After this time, the Fatacil facility management will close the gates to the park.
